

### **Curriculum Intent:**

To enable pupils to be open-minded and culturally sensitive individuals while inspiring a love of languages. The MFL department strives to instil confidence in pupils to be able to communicate ad empathise with the global community.

### 'Why This, Why Now?'

In our planning, we have asked ourselves 'why this, why now?' Year 7 begins with an introduction to the basics of the language, including phonetic and spelling patterns and basic grammar such as agreements and word order. They develop their ability to understand classroom commands and to use basic classroom language among themselves and with the teacher appropriately. Pupils develop the ability to introduce themselves, ask others about personal information and to express what activities they usually do. They begin to develop their ability to express opinions and preferences. Year 7 then moves onto describing the people around them: friends, family, pets, and to express simple opinions with justifications. Year 7 further develops their ability to describe their surroundings such as houses, places in town and express preferences about where they would like to live in the future. Finally, the topic of School, is highly relevant as this is the year, they have all moved to secondary school and it embraces this change and is also a good discussion point: favourite subjects, opinions of teachers, timetables and much more.

The Medium-Term Planning document below is designed to show the journey that every student takes through our curriculum. Some elements of the curriculum may be taught over several lessons, others in a single lesson.
